Cookie Truffles

These fabulous treats can be made either with Oreo cookies or, for a peanut-buttery twist, with Nutter Butters.

Ingredients

- 1 package Oreo or Nutter Butter cookies, finely crushed in food processor
- 1 8 oz. package cream cheese, cut into 1" cubes
- 2 packages (8 squares each) semi-sweet chocolate, melted
- 8 oz. white chocolate chips or almond bark, melted

With the food processor, mix cream cheese cubes into 3 cups of the cookie crumbs until well-blended.

Shape the cookie/cream cheese mixture into 1" balls. (This recipe makes about 42 balls). Chill the cookie balls in the refrigerator for one hour to make them easier to handle.

Once chilled, dip balls in melted chocolate (use two forks and roll them around until evenly coated; allow excess to drip off) and place on wax paper.

Using a spoon, drizzle stripes of the melted white chocolate over the truffles for special flare!



2011 Energy Tax Credits!

Homeowners can receive a [tax credit](#) for installing energy efficient [windows](#), [doors](#), roofs and insulation in their primary residence. Under the new law for 2011, the total tax credit allowed per homeowner is \$500. New rules allow homeowners to claim up to 10 percent of the costs of installed [windows](#), [doors](#), roofs and insulation.* Visit [EnergyStar.gov](#) for full information on the tax credits.

New Rules

The new rules allow homeowners to claim up to 10 percent of the costs of installed windows, doors, roofs and insulation. The rules also cap the amount for an air conditioner, heat pump or water heater at \$300; a furnace at \$150; and windows at \$200.

Save Your Receipt

New energy efficient windows and skylights must be Energy Star ® certified or meet the International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) to qualify for the window tax credit. Only the price of the windows can be deducted; not installation costs. Remember to save your receipt on these items as well as the Energy Star label from your windows to claim this tax credit.
