Easy Irish Soda Bread

This makes a moist quick bread that is just as good toasted for breakfast as it is an accompaniment for stew

or corned beef.

Ingredients:

3 cups all-purpose flour
1 tablespoon baking powder
1/3 cup white sugar
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon baking soda
1/2 cup raisins
1 egg, lightly beaten
2 cups buttermilk
1/4 cup butter, melted

Directions:

Combine flour, baking powder, sugar, salt, baking soda and raisins in a large bowl. Blend egg and buttermilk together, and add all at once to the flour mixture. Mix just until moistened. Stir in butter. Pour into a greased 9x5 inch greased loaf pan. Bake for 65 to 70 minutes in a preheated 325 degree oven. Cool on a wire rack. Wrap the loaf in foil and let sit several hours or overnight for best flavor.
